

CANTEEN POLICY

The canteen is staffed by volunteers drawn from the school community and is managed by a volunteer Canteen Committee. The Canteen Committee is a subcommittee of the school P & C.

The committee meets regularly to determine policy, rosters, special events and consider correspondence.

Parents who are rostered on to canteen duty are responsible for arranging a replacement if they are indisposed and unable to work in the canteen.

The P&C's insurance policy covers accidents that may occur when volunteers are assisting in the canteen. This policy does not cover accidents to pre-school children or students attending the school. For this reason, parent volunteers are advised that children are not permitted in the canteen.

The canteen provides a 5 day-a-week service to the children and staff of the school. However, the canteen is unable to cater for any special dietary requirements of students. Nor is the canteen equipped for heating food for individual children or storing student lunches in fridges.

Profits generated from canteen sales are donated to the P&C.
